



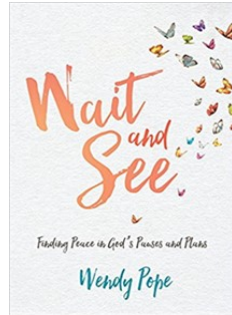

# A Journey Through Lent

On Sunday mornings we will gather for Worship at 9:00a.m. using ELW Setting 3 and traditional Lenten Hymns. Wednesday Nights will be Intergenerational Events that include a soup supper, education, group activity and Worship. The schedule is: 5:15p.m. Soup Supper; 6:00p.m. Education divided by ages; 6:20 p.m.

Intergenerational Activity; 6:45p.m. Worship. Everyone is invited for all of the activities or to come and go as they are able. The Wednesday night theme is God's Own People. It is based on 1 Peter and reminds those who would follow Jesus that they are born anew into a wonderful inheritance as God's own people: trusted, called, made holy, and proclaiming. This doesn't guarantee that their faith won't be tested or that they won't experience suffering, but 1 Peter assures its readers that their relationship with God is guaranteed by the death and resurrection of Jesus. In the end, we won't be put to shame. And in the meantime, we cast our burdens on Christ who loves us beyond measure!
