



We are very lucky to have such a wonderful education program here at Faith ELC for so many years. Many great people have helped to raise many great children in this church.

We have new exciting opportunities for education beginning next

school year. We will be using the title Faith Formation to encompass all of these programs.

The first Wednesday every month we will be having **Faithline**: Family Faith Formation. Parents, siblings, grandparents, friends, anyone and everyone are welcome to join us. These classes will be focused on learning about parts of the worship service and previewing the curriculum for the rest of the month.
