#### **Internship Report**

Vicar Lily, your Lay Internship committee and myself worked very hard in February to complete all the paperwork required by the seminary, candidacy committee and synod so that she is eligible for call to serve as a minister of Word and Sacrament in the ELCA. We completed Vicar Lily's final evaluations at the end of February in preparation for her seminary and synod candidacy final interviews being held in March and April. We are on track for Vicar Lily's internship to be completed by the end of May. When all of Vicar Lily's seminary, synod and candidacy's requirements are complete, we will enter the call process for her to be your resident pastor. I appreciate your partnership, shared ministry and grace as this two-year process comes to a close.

#### **Transition Process**

The community and congregation reflection and data gathering groups have completed their work and we have approximately 6 pages of raw data to shift through. We need 3-4 people to help work through the data gathered and prepare a one-page conversation sheet for both the congregation and community reflection discussions to be held in April. 




