Friday and Saturdays I will also have more family time and time finishing sermons. Sundays I'm all yours!

I will get back to my "Vicar on the Go!" type videos, as I work on a clever new title, perhaps, "Pastor on the Path!" Also, I will continue learning more about the community, church history and passions within.
