





Starting February 1st the Gathering Space at FELC will have a new banner. Created by our 5th and 6th graders and CHAOS Youth Group, the banner will be orange with black letters stating: "We Remember the Children." As you know, Amanda and Rebecca were on a mission trip in July to the Leech Lake Reservation in MN. On that trip, they learned about boarding schools run by Christian churches. Native children were forced to attend these schools, forbidden from speaking their native language, and physically forced to take on Christian culture. Many children perished at these school. This past summer a mass grave of 215 children from the Kamloops Residential School was found. Bodies of children from the Rosebud Sioux were also returned home. The American Indian Alaska Native Lutheran Association has asked that churches hang a orange banner for 225 days to remember these children and other indigenous children treated without respect. Our banner will hang in the Gathering Space until September 13, 2022.




Anyone interested in participating in our 2 mini cantatas, please let Rachel West know (262-812-3786 or rachelrita22@gmail.com). The first one will be
