Railroad work to require full closure of WIS 67 The WisDOT is notifying motorists of an upcoming

Wisconsin Department of Transportation full closure of WIS 67 in the city of Walworth.

Wisconsin & Southern Railroad is performing repairs at their railroad crossing between High Street and Lakeview Drive. To complete their work, crews require a full closure from April 28 to May 13, 2022. Access to nearby businesses and residences will be maintained up to closure. Please note that this closure is weather dependent and subject to change. An official detour will be posted using US 14, I-43, and WIS 50.






