Do you pray?

How often do you pray? Who do you pray for? What does your prayer life look like?

We pray together at worship on Wednesday and Sunday. We pray together for our members and community that are in need of extra healing and care within our newsletters and bulletins. Many committee meetings start with a devotion or prayer and many end with the Lord's Prayer. In Confirmation and Faith Formation Class we take specific time to talk about prayer and why we do it.

Let's return to my previous question, "do you pray"?

God loves you, God loves to hear from you. Coming together in prayer is wonderful and needed within our community in Christ, and additionally we need to brush up on our prayer life individually.

Is prayer for you or for God?
