A Message from Pastor Lily

Life never truly seems to slow down but most would say that Summer has a feeling about it, a feeling of freedom, a feeling of taking a breath and a change of pace. Then we will blink and Fall will start again with the excitement of wearing a sweater once more, with cooler nights and schedules filling up as well. Before too long Winter will make an appearance too, with shorter days, snow, ice storms, cancellations, holidays and more indoor activities. These are words I continue to live by, it gives me hope, and it helps me to realize even when we are promised new life, transformation and good things in the future, the timeline for such isn’t drawn out, so we must keep looking towards hope even days it seems more distant. Spring is coming!


