



How often do we chat about the larger church? We are so connected in beautiful ways that we owe it to ourselves to talk about these connections! We are the Church, we are part of the bigger Body of Christ.

We are a part of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America. This church body is broken down into 65 smaller sections which are called synods. We are a part of the South Central Synod of Wisconsin, which is then made up of 133 congregations.

We meet annually in May at the Synod Assembly with two representatives from our churches. We also meet annually in August at the Churchwide Assembly with representatives from the synods across the USA. We gather to worship, learn and create change in an ever evolving world. God transforms us into a more inclusive, always welcoming community showing the radical love of Christ in the world.

A Message from Pastor Lily

One of my goals this year is to share more about the ELCA and our connections to the synod. In high school I was the youth representative on the synod council working with the bishop. Then throughout college I was a lay female representative and was a representative for our synod at the churchwide assembly. I also shepherded my home pastor into becoming a bishop of our synod a few years before I started seminary.

I have lived and breathed our larger church opportunities my whole life, and I am called to share more of this with you.

For example, at our last synod assembly May 20, 2023 three resolutions passed, and I am excited to see where our church takes these.

Resolution 1: Care of Creation

Congregations are encouraged to care for creation better. The resolution recommends that congregations create and submit a brief Congregational Care for Creation Plan to the synod Care for Creation Team before the end of the year.

Resolution 2: Updating Reconciling in Christ Commitments

We are called to update and review our commitment as a synod in being Reconciling in Christ (RIC) and encourage the churches within our synod to look into becoming RIC. (We are already moving in a great direction!)

Resolution 3: Land Acknowledgement

The synod will appoint a Land Acknowledgement Taskforce to develop a land acknowledgement for use in the synod and to assist congregations in developing their own.

At the churchwide level a team has been formed within the last few months to start a two year conversation and commitment to "Restructuring the ELCA". We are always being made new, and we are always reforming into an even better church.

Systems will continue to fail us, communities will continue to fail us, because we are a bunch of imperfect people. So we are relying on something bigger. We are following a God that is bigger, bolder and more beautiful than we can imagine. With God on our side, I am so empowered to see where this organization/church/community is headed! I will keep you updated!


