# A Message from Pastor Lily

We are called to love others. We are called to serve others. We are called to live and treat others as Jesus did. This time of year leading up to "God's Work. Our Hands." Sunday, September 10th, we start gathering our forces and look outward to where we can help.

Looking back, some of the first times I remember learning personally about serving my neighbors was when my parents packed up all the sweet corn from our patch and delivered it to members of our church community and to our neighbors around town. Nothing was expected in return; it was just the joy of sharing what we had been blessed with.

As a teenager I went on mission trips with my church youth group, and we served others in ways I had never done before. One year we went to Philadelphia and worked in soup kitchens serving meals and homeless shelters organizing donations. We also worked with a church that was in the beginning stages of making their space inclusive for our LGBTQIA+ siblings. We gave our time and learned from others.

In high school I went with my pastor to "take your daughter to work day." I grew in my call to ministry. We brought communion to homebound members of the church, and we talked about life and the future. She listened to me and wanted to hear about my interests, what it was like believing in God and going to high school. There is power in conversation, sitting in one another's presence and listening.

For this "God's Work. Our Hands." Sunday we will combine all of our notes on serving others and celebrate with one another. (see info on previous page)

Another opportunity to serve our community has come up as well. This year at Faith we have the largest confirmation class we have had in a while. We have the ability to learn with and from our young people, while we serve others and grow in our faith in God and the Body of Christ among us.

We are looking for attentive adults that will be mentors to our confirmation students. Mentors will be paired with 2-3 students to journey with them through the years of confirmation.

**Requirements:** 

- Be present for an information session with Pastor Lily
- Attend 4-6 classes per year to observe and lead small groups
- Check in with mentees bi-weekly via after worship chat, text, email or call
- Participate in service and special projects as scheduled




